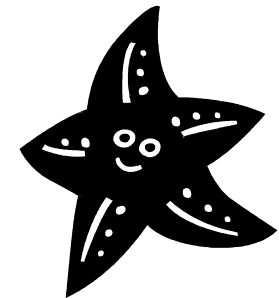

Class Schedule

PERIOD 1 – 7:30-9:55

Summer Fitness & Fun: You will choose from such activities as golf, soccer, softball, badminton, paddleball and basketball. You will also use the new fitness machines in Rosemont's fitness room.

Junior Book Reviewer: This class examines current issues facing middle school students through small group study and discussion of young adult literature. You will choose from a selection of titles and practice how to pick out important themes and relevant topics from the books you read both in future English classes and during independent reading. \$25 materials fee. *

Tall Tales & Short Stories: Do you have a writer's imagination? If yes, then you need to take this class. Tall Tales & Short Stories is a course in creative writing that will teach you all the elements needed to compose great works of original short fiction. By entering the world of writers, you have the ability to create interesting characters and place them in amazing settings, while having them face compelling circumstances in action-packed intricate plot lines. All you need to provide is your imagination and creativity. \$12 materials fee.*

Project Adventure: WILSON MIDDLE SCHOOL: Want to have fun while learning how to work in small groups, trusting and challenging one another? Want to build confidence in yourself and your abilities? Want to make new friends, obtain some outdoor recreation skills like navigation and map reading? Or do you want to challenge yourself to climb a rock wall? Then this class is for you! Come be part of the adventure! \$15 materials fee. *

Design, Build & Test: Make a bottle rocket with an egganaut; a truss bridge; a gravity dragster and a glider airplane, plus other items if time permits! \$20 materials fee.*

Make Your Own Documentary!: You will plan, create and screen your own documentaries. Some of the activities will be: creative writing, interviewing, producing, and researching. In addition, you will study professional documentaries like "King of Kong."

Kitchen Creations: Do you like to cook and be creative in the kitchen? Then this is the class for you. Preparing cookies, pies, cakes, pizza and more. Become a Culinary Master in this hands-on cooking class. \$20 materials fee.*

PERIOD 2 - 10:20-12:45

Fitness 101 & Sports Skills: In this fun and exciting class you will learn the basics of fitness concepts including circuit training while using weight and fitness equipment. Learn the basic nutritional information to effectively reach your fitness goals. Build confidence in your sport skills by practicing basketball, volleyball, softball and soccer leading into team tournaments, drills and relays.

Guitar Beginnings: Would you like to learn to play the guitar? Sign up for this class and you'll be strumming along with ease by the end of July. You will show off your new talents at a performance at the end of summer school. Students need to bring their own guitar or make special arrangements at registration.

Survive at Middle School: Join one of Rosemont's most popular teachers, Mr. Grant, and get a head start on all you will need to know to thrive, not just survive, in middle school. We will focus on organization, note taking and teacher expectations for middle school.

Grow with Golf!: This fun and unique program offers you a chance to take an introduction to the sport, its basic components and the etiquette involved in a challenging, yet low-pressure environment specially tailored to the needs of the beginning golfer. Creative Woodworking: Come and develop your skills in woodworking. Have fun making special projects while using hand tools, portable power tools and woodworking machines. \$25 materials fee.

Summer Book Club: Combining reading strategies with writing applications to promote efficiency, you will be encouraged to voice your opinions and share their ideas critically about your readings. Various artistic mediums will stimulate the imagination and lead to successful readers and sharp thinkers.

Masters of Multimedia! Create! Collaborate! Communicate! You will create your own website to showcase original multimedia artwork and presentations, including: video, music, avatars and animations, digital drawing and photography. Collaborate with your friends to write and star in a movie or music video. Communicate with your teachers, family members and classmates with your own private blog. \$15 materials fee. *

Greek Gods and You! In this course, you will be given a front row seat to the colorful world of classical mythology and literature. You will learn the basics of Greek and Roman mythology and explore their literature from Greek dramas to epic poems.
